

Uphill Putts – a thought!

If faced with an uphill putt, don't be afraid to hit it more firmly than you might think necessary.

For one thing, gravity is on your side.

Another plus is that the far side of the hole is slightly higher than the near side, so in effect the back of the hole becomes a backstop.

Now assuming you've chosen the correct line - uphill putts tend not to break too much - you can then make a run at it, safe in the knowledge that when your ball passes over the hole it will fall slightly and hit the "wall" behind the hole - the back of the cup.
